







The TV should be kept free from rain, damp and dust to prevent electrical shock and short circuits.

Do not cover the ventilation openings with table clothes, curtains, newspapers etc.

The TV should be kept from high temperature heating objects or direct sunlight. It requires good ventilation. Allow 10cm between the TV and other appliances or built-in cabinet walls.






You may clean the display panel with a soft clean cloth after pulling out the power plug. Do not repeatedly wipe the panel, nor scrape, tap or strike the panel with a hard object.


Do not wipe the TV with any petrol, chemical or alcohol based solvents as it will lead to product damage of the panel and cabinet.






Do not place the TV on an unstable surface.

Do not place the power cord or other cables across a walkway in case it is trampled on. Do not overload the power cord or power socket.





Do not disassemble the back cover as it contains high voltages inside and will cause electric shock. Internal adjustments and checks should only be conducted by qualified professionals.



Please pull out the power plug and contact after sales support if there are abnormal objects or water in the TV.





Pull out the power cord and antenna cable during electrical storms so the TV is not damaged by electrical surges. Keep all people away from the antenna cable during electrical storms.



Do not touch the power plug with wet hands . If the cordpin is wet or covered with dust , dry the power plug completely or wipe dust off . You may be electrocuted due to excess moisture .

Do not let your children climb or cling onto the TV. Otherwise, the TV may fall over, which may cause serious injury.





Do not use unqualified power adapter and powercord. Otherwise, it may cause electric shock and product damage.




#### **Base installation schematic diagram**


- 1.Please pay attention to the "L" / "R" marked on the TV base to avoid wrong installation

- 1.Lift and tilt the TV into its upright position on a table.
- 2.Leave a 10 cm (minimum) space from the wall for proper ventilation
- 3.Do not place the TV near or on sources of heat, as this may result in fire or other damage.



Step 3 : Fasten another 2 pieces of brackets on TV , make sure it is well screwed



- 4. The installation height of TV bracket should not be higher than 2 metres.

This equipment can use the above two kinds of remote controls at the same time. The remote controls equipped with this machine shall be subject to the real objects in the packing box.

The voice recognition function of this device must be equipped with magic remote control to use. If the model you purchased is not equipped with magic remote control, you need to contact your sales department and purchase it separately.



For buttons with #, please long-press (hold for more than a second).

#### Using the magic remote

- 1.If you shake the Magic Remote left and right or turn its wheel while pointing it at the TV, a pointer will appear on the TV screen. If you move the remote control to the direction you want, the pointer follows the movement.
- 2. Move the pointer to the location you want and press the Wheel (OK) button to execute the function.
- 3. If the pointer has not been used for a certain period of time, it will disappear.
  - When the pointer disappears from the screen, shake the Magic Remote right and left. It will then re-appear.
  - The pointer will disappear if you press the up, down, left or right buttons, and the remote will work as a conventional remote.
- If the pointer is not responding smoothly, you can reset the pointer by moving it to the edge of the screen.
- Use the remote control within the specified range (within 10 metres). The
  device may not function properly when outside the working distance or
  when an obstacle blocks the line of sight.
- Depending on the peripherals (wireless router, microwave oven, etc.), communication failures may occur.
- Impacts can cause the Magic Remote to malfunction.
- Take care not to bump into nearby furniture, electronic equipment or other people when using the Magic Remote.

#### Register the magic remote

To use the Magic Remote, first pair it with your TV.

- 1.Put batteries into the Magic Remote and turn the TV on.
- 2.Point the Magic Remote at your TV and press the Wheel or the remote control.
- \* If the TV fails to register the Magic Remote, try again after turning the TV off and back on.

#### Deregister the magic remote

Press the and buttons at the same time, for five seconds, to unpair the Magic Remote with your TV.

\* Pressing and holding the button will let you cancel and reregister Magic Remote at once.

#### Introduction for each key in TV set

#### Introduction for each key in TV set

1 POWER (ON/OFF)

Turn the TV on or enter into standby mode.

2 Source (INPUT)

This TV set has different signal source modes, you may continue to press the Source button to select a signal source.

MENU

Enter/exit the main menu.

4 VOL- (V-)

Volume decreasing short cut key; enter into the next menu and adjust OSD options (decreasing).

**6** VOL+(V+)

Volume increasing short cut key; enter into the next menu and adjust OSD options(increasing).

6 CH-

Channel decreasing short cut key; decrease the channel No. and select the last option in the menu.

7 CH+

Channel increasing short cut key; increase the channel No. and select the next option in the menu.

- 8 Power/standby indicator
- Remote control sensor

Some model only have POWER(ON/OFF) in the TV set.

#### **Antenna Connections**


#### Notes:

The remote control shall be applied in effective reception scope of the television. Make the remote control point towards the infrared receiver of the liquid crystal television and ensure that there are no obstacles. Its normal operation distance will be shortened in direct sunlight or lamplight.

Be careful to use the remote control, avoid falling off or being trampled or splashed with liquids.

#### Batteries in stallation of Remote-Control Unit

- 1. Turn the remote-control unit upside down. Scratch the grip of the battery compartment.
- 2. Install two new 1.5V AAA batteries, make sure the anode and cathode of the batteries matches the +, marks inside the battery compartment. If not, the unit will be damaged.



3. Close the battery compartment cover.


NOTES: Batteries shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

#### **Antenna Connections**

We recommend you use a  $75\Omega$  coaxial cable so as to eliminate the disturbance caused by impedance mismatching. The antenna cable shall not be bundled together with the power cord .

Directly insert the 75  $\Omega$  coaxial cable plug into the antenna socket when applying cable television.

Note: The antenna should be checked periodically. If clear image is not available, shut down the power and then carefully check the antenna.



Please pay attention that the outlet to be grounded!

#### Power-on/Power-off

The television is in standby state when no images arise and the red indicating lamp shines.

Press the power button again on the remote control or the television, the indicating lamp becomes green, and then television image is available.

Press the power button on the remote, controller or the television to enter into standby state.

#### Power -saving & protection mode

1.In video or PC state, the television will enter into lower power sleep state (standby state) to conduct power saving and protection after several minutes with no signal inputs.


# Watching television programs

#### Watching television programs


Connect the power cord, press POWER button to power on the television, then press the SOURCE button to select TV channel mode to watch television programs.

Select Channels Via Program No.


1.If you want to select program no. from 0-9: directly press numeral key to input the program no., it will enter into the selected program, e.g. select program no. 1



2.If you want to select program number from 10-99: Input the channel number you desired, e.g. select channel 12.



3.If you want to select program number from 100-100+: Input the channel number you desired, e.g. select channel 100.



#### Channel select

1. Use the buttons on the television panel to conduct channel selection. First press "CH+/-" buttons on the side of the TV to enter into channel selection mode state.




2. "CH+/-" buttons of the remote control may also be applied to conduct channel selection.

#### Channel return

#### **Return To Program**

Press RECALL buttons to return to previous program.




#### Volume control

- 1. Use the buttons "VOL +/VOL-" of television panel to control the volume.
- 2. "VOL+/VOL-" buttons on the remote control also manage volume control.




#### Sound elimination

Press "MUTE" button to eliminate the sound. Press the button again or press the volume control button of the television panel or the remote control for audio recovery.



#### System state display

Press " button of the remote control, then it will display the current program number, current input mode and information relevant.



#### **Connections (notifications)**

Connect various external devices to the TV and switch input modes to select an external device. For more information of external device's connection, refer to the manual provided with each device.

Available external devices are: HD receivers, DVD players, VCRs, audio systems, USB storage devices, PC, gaming devices, and other external devices.

- 1. The external devices connection may differ from the models.
- 2. Connect external devices to the TV regardless of the order of the TV ports.
- 3. If you record a TV program on a DVD recorder or VCR, make sure to connect the TV signal input cable to the TV through a DVD recorder or VCR. For more information of recording, refer to the manual provided with the connected device.
- 4. Refer to the external equipment's manual for operating instructions.
- 5. If you connect a gaming device to the TV, use the cable supplied with the gaming device.
- 6. In PC mode, there may be noise associated with the resolution, vertical pattern, contrast or brightness. If noise is present, change the PC output to another resolution, change the refresh rate to another rate or adjust the brightness and contrast on the PICTURE menu until the picture is clear.
- 7. In PC mode, some resolution settings may not work properly depending on the graphics card.
- 8. If ULTRA HD content is played on your PC, video or audio may become disrupted intermittently depending on your PC's performance. (Depending on model)

#### **Antenna connection**

Connect the TV to a wall antenna socket with an RF cable (75  $\Omega$ ).

- 1. Use a signal splitter to use more than 2 TVs.
- 2. If the image quality is poor, install a signal amplifier properly to improve the image quality.
- 3. If the image quality is poor with an antenna connected, try to realign the antenna in the correct direction.
- 4. An antenna cable and converter are not supplied.
- 5. Supported DTV Audio: MPEG, Dolby Digital, Dolby Digital Plus, HE-AAC
- 6. For a location that is not supported with ULTRA HD broadcasting, this TV cannot receive ULTRA HD broadcasts directly. (Depending on model)

Satellite dish connection (Only satellite models)

Connect the TV to a satellite dish or a satellite socket with a satellite RF cable (75  $\Omega$ ).

CI module connection (Depending on model)

View the encrypted (pay) services in digital TV mode.

- 1. Check if the CI module is inserted into the PCMCIA card slot in the right direction. If the module is not inserted properly, this can cause damage to the TV and the PCMCIA card slot.
- 2. If the TV does not display any video and audio when CI+ CAM is connected, please contact to the Terrestrial/Cable/Satellite Service Operator.

#### **USB** connection

Some USB Hubs may not work. If a USB device connected using a USB Hub is not detected, connect it to the USB port on the TV directly

#### Other connections

Connect your TV to external devices. For the best picture and audio quality, connect the external device and the TV with the HDMI cable. Some separate cable is not provided.



- On: Support 4K @ 50/60 Hz (4:4:4, 4:2:2, 4:2:0)
- Off: Support 4K @ 50/60 Hz 8 bit (4:2:0)

If the device connected to Input Port also supports ULTRA HD Deep Colour, your picture may be clearer. However, if the device doesn't support it, it may not work properly. In that case, connect the device to a different HDMI port or change the TV's HDMI ULTRA HD Deep Colour setting to Off.

(This feature is available on certain models which are supported ULTRA HD Deep Colour only.)

Unclear picture or picture with snow.	<ul> <li>Check the direction, position and connection of your antenna.</li> <li>Adjust the direction of your antenna or reset or fine tune the channel.</li> </ul>
The remote control does not work.	<ul> <li>Change the batteries in the remote control.</li> <li>Clean the upper side of the remote control.(radiating window)</li> <li>Check the contacting points of the batteries.</li> <li>Check if there is obstruction between the remote</li> </ul>
	control and the monitor.  Check if the batteries are correctly installed.


