IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS



WARNING: This Symbol Indicates Situations that could cause injury to the user and third parties.

CAUTION

RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK DO NOT OPEN



WARNING This Symbol is intended to alert the user to the presence of uninsulated dangerous voltage within the product's enclosure that may be of sufficient magnitude to constitute a risk of electric shock.

High voltages are used in the operation of this product. To reduce the risk of electric shock,do not remove cover of the cabinet. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel only.



To avoid possible hearing damage, do not listen at high audio volume for long periods of time.

Read these safety instructions before using your device and store them for possible future reference.

- •This device must only be connected to a mains network whose characteristics are identical to those shown on the device identification plate.
- •The mains plug must always be easily accessible. It serves as a mains disconnecting switch to the device.
- •To disconnect the device from the mains, the plug must be disconnected. Hold the mains cable by its plug. Do not pull on the mains cable to disconnect the plug.
- •The mains cable must be routed so that it is not trampled upon or pinched by objects placed on or against it.


- •CAUTION: danger of explosion or fire if the batteries are not inserted correctly or if they are replaced by a nonsimilar or incompatible model.



The marks and positions of the remote control buttons may vary depending on the model.



Using the Magic Remote

- 1.If you shake the Magic Remote left and right or turn its wheel while pointing it at the TV, a pointer will appear on the TV screen. If you move the remote control to the direction you want, the pointer follows the movement.
- 2. Move the pointer to the location you want and press the Wheel (OK) button to execute the function.
- 3. If the pointer has not been used for a certain period of time, it will disappear.
 - When the pointer disappears from the screen, shake the Magic Remote right and left. It will then re-appear.
 - The pointer will disappear if you press the up, down, left or right buttons, and the remote will work as a conventional remote.
- If the pointer is not responding smoothly, you can reset the pointer by moving it to the edge of the screen.
- Use the remote control within the specified range (within 10 metres). The device may not function properly when outside the working distance or when an obstacle blocks the line of sight.
- Interference from nearby electrical appliances (wireless router. microwave oven, etc.) may cause communication issues with Magic Remote
- Impacts can cause the Magic Remote to malfunction.
- Take care not to bump into nearby furniture, electronic equipment or other people when using the Magic Remote.

Register the magic remote

To use the Magic Remote, first pair it with your TV.

- 1.Put batteries into the Magic Remote and turn the TV on.
- 2.Point the Magic Remote at your TV and press the Wheel the remote control.



* If the TV fails to register the Magic Remote, try again after turning the TV off and back on.

Deregister the magic remote

Press the and buttons at the same time, for five seconds, to unpair the Magic Remote with your TV.

* Pressing and holding the button will let you cancel and re-register Magic Remote at once.

REMOTE CONTROL PREPARATION

BATTERY INSTALLATION


Install the batteries as per the following pictures. Be sure + and – terminals are positioned as indicated in the battery compartment (Fig1).

SERVICE LIFE OF BATTERIES

- The batteries normally last for one year although this depends on how often the remote control is used.
- If the remote control fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the batteries.
- Use two size AAA dry batteries.

NOTES:

- The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.
- Do not point bright light at remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control and the remote control sensor.




NOTE:

- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries.

ACCESSORIES

Please make sure the following items are included with your TV. If any items are missing, contact your dealer.



Note:

The type of remote control that comes with your TV is dependent on the TV Model and it's functions.

INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION

STAND/FEET INSTALLATION

Step 1

Place the TV faced down on a soft cloth or cushion to prevent the panel from being damaged.

Step 2

Align the Stand with TV bottom and then fit the end of stand until the TV is fully seated on the stand.

Step 3


Tighten the included screws with a screw driver taking care not to over-tighten the screws.

Step 4


- 1. Lift and tilt the TV into its upright position on a table.
- 2. Leave a 10 cm (minimum) space from the wall for proper ventilation
- 3. Do not place the TV near or on sources of heat, as this may result in fire or other damage.

NOTES:

- Unplug the power plug first when installing or removing the TV Stand.
- To avoid any damage to this TV, it is recommend that another person assists when installing or removing the TV stand.
- This picture is for reference only and may be different in practice.








WALL MOUNTING INSTALLATION

- 1. Contact a professional for assistance when wall mounting your TV. We are not responsible for any damage to the product or injury to yourself, if you mount the TV on your own.
- 2. Do not wall mount the TV while TV is turned on. It may cause personal injury due to electric shock.
- 3. This TV is for use only with the wall mount bracket which the manufacturer recommends. Use with unsuitable wall mount brackets may result in instability causing injury.

BASIC CONNECTION


- Ensure all the cables are disconnected from the main unit before connecting to AC power source.
- Read through the instructions before connecting other equipment.

CONNECTING TO THE AC POWER



CONNECT EXTERNAL ANTENNA TO UNIT

Install external antenna into antenna jack for best picture.



Connections (notifications)

Connect various external devices to the TV and switch input modes to select an external device. For more information of external device's connection, refer to the manual provided with each device.

Typical external devices are: HD receivers, DVD players, audio systems, USB storage devices, PC, gaming devices, and other external devices.

- 1. The external devices connection may differ from the model to model.
- 2. Connect external devices to the TV regardless of the order of the TV ports.
- 3. If you record a TV programme on a DVD recorder or VCR, make sure to connect the TV signal input cable to the TV through a DVD recorder or VCR. For more information on recording, refer to the manual provided with the connected device.
- 4. Refer to the external equipment's manual for operating instructions.
- 5. If you connect a gaming device to the TV, use the cable supplied with the gaming device.
- 6. In PC mode, there may be noise associated with the resolution, vertical pattern, contrast or brightness. If noise is present, change the PC output to another resolution, change the refresh rate to another rate or adjust the brightness and contrast on the PICTURE menu until the picture is clear.
- 7. In PC mode, some resolution settings may not work properly depending on the graphics card.
- 8. If ULTRA HD content is played on your PC, video or audio may become disrupted intermittently depending on your PC's performance. (Depending on model)

Antenna connection

Connect the TV to a wall antenna socket with an RF cable (75 Ω).

- 1. Use a signal splitter to use more than 2 TV's.
- 2. If the image quality is poor, install a signal amplifier properly to improve the image quality.
- 3. If the image quality is poor with an antenna connected, try to realign the antenna in the correct direction.
- 4. An antenna cable and converter are not supplied.
- 5. Supported DTV Audio: MPEG, Dolby Digital, Dolby Digital Plus, HE-AAC
- 6. For a location that is not supported with ULTRA HD broadcasting, this TV cannot receive ULTRA HD broadcasts directly. (Depending on model)

Satellite dish connection (Only satellite models)

Connect the TV to a satellite dish or a satellite socket with a satellite RF cable (75 Ω).

CI module connection (Depending on model)

View the encrypted (pay) services in digital TV mode.

- 1. Check if the CI module is inserted into the PCMCIA card slot in the right direction. If the module is not inserted properly, this can cause damage to the TV and the PCMCIA card slot.
- 2. If the TV does not display any video and audio when CI+ CAM is connected, please contact to the Terrestrial/Cable/Satellite Service Operator.

USB connection

Some USB Hubs may not work. If a USB device connected using a USB Hub is not detected, connect it to the USB port on the TV directly.

Other connections

Connect your TV to external devices. For the best picture and audio quality, connect the external device and the TV with a HDMI cable.



- On: Support 4K @ 50/60 Hz (4:4:4, 4:2:2, 4:2:0)
- Off: Support 4K @ 50/60 Hz 8 bit (4:2:0)

If the device connected to an Input Port also supports ULTRA HD Deep Colour, your picture may be clearer. However, if the device doesn't support it, it may not work properly. In that case, connect the device to a different HDMI port or change the TV's HDMI ULTRA HD Deep Colour setting to Off.

(This feature is available on certain models which are supported ULTRA HD Deep Colour only.)

No sound or picture.	 Check if the power line is in the outlet and if it has electricity. Check if you have pressed Power button on the TV or Power button on the remote control. Check the setting of picture brightness and contrast. Check the volume. Check if Mute mode is set.
The picture is normal but there is no sound.	Check the volume.Check if Mute mode is set.
No picture and white or black picture.	Adjust Picture Setting.Check Colour System.
Interference in sound or picture	 A nearby Appliance may be affecting your signal, try & identify the appliance & remove it from the area. Insert the power plug of the TV set into another outlet.
Unclear picture or picture with snow.	 Check the direction, position and connection of your antenna. Adjust the direction of your antenna or reset or fine tune the channel.
The remote control does not work.	 Change the batteries in the remote control. Clean the upper side of the remote control (radiating window) Check the contacting points of the batteries. Check if there is obstruction between the remote control and the TV. Check if the batteries are correctly installed.


